Recent News

- We hope that you enjoyed watching the KS1 Nativity Plays and the KS2 Advent Concert at the end of term. Thank you for donating money at the end of these concerts, we raised an amazing £972.00 which will be equally distributed to the charities: The Cardinal Hume Centre and The Passage. Thank you all so much for your generosity. I will be organising a representative from both Cardinal Hume and The Passage to talk to the children about their valuable work. It is important the children understand how this money will help the wider community.

Year 5 have trained as Dementia Friends and have thoroughly enjoyed visiting the café chatting to all its guests this term. The choir visited and sang carols to help everyone get in the festive spirit. We are looking forward to visiting again in the spring term.
