This year we enjoyed making masks to show that we are superstars.

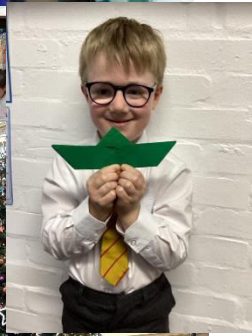
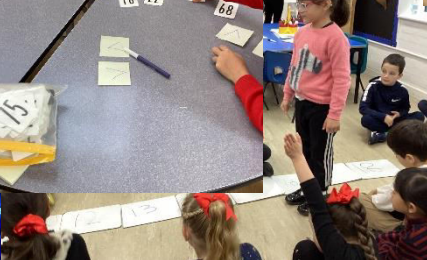
