RE	In R.E this half term our topic is called 'The Eastertide'. We are learning about Jesus coming back from the grave and giving us the Holy Spirit and giving us wonderful gifts.

Our second half term is focusing on 'The Church is born'. We will be discussing how the Holy Spirit worked through the disciples, how miracles continued to happen and how it affects us still. Our other faith is still Judaism, we are learning about the Passover and the festival of Hanukkah.

### Science

This term we are learning about plants. We are deepening our knowledge in identifying parts of a plant, observing similarities and differences in seeds and the effects of water, warmth and light on plants. We shall also be looking at how living things are suited to the habitat that they live in.

#### DT

We shall be making our own vehicles! We shall be looking at different types of vehicles, their key features, what an axle is and its use. We shall then be designing and making our own vehicles for a specific purpose.

## History

Our history topic is 'The Great Fire of London'. We shall be learning key dates in the history of Britain, asking historical questions, describing the key events of the fire and changes we have now made after the Great Fire. We shall be using primary and secondary sources to help us deduce information.

# Computing

Our topic for this term is 'Logo'. We will be learning to program and move our turtle to make a variety of shapes. This will introduce angles of a shape and directional language.

#### Music

In our Music this half term we will be focusing on singing and performance skills. We will be exploring a unit by Kapow called 'On this Island' which is about songs and sounds from the British Isles.

## PΕ

P.E is on Monday and Friday. We will still be doing P.E outside for games lesson so please ensure they have their track suit and trainers in their kit. Our first half term topic we are continuing 'Gymnastics' and our next half term topic is 'Athletics'.

#### RHE
